Board Meeting

July 12, 2011

President Mitch Larson called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m.

Chris Pendergraft moved we approve the June 14, 2011 minutes, Mike Edelman seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Budget/Financials: Mitch Larson and Herbie Johnson explained the monthly Profit/Loss ledger for RCC and the Clubhouse. We currently have 307 members. Mitch complimented all managers for staying within their budgets, especially with employee wages.

Clubhouse/Restaurant: Barbara Snyder said Janette purchased a new freezer to replace one that quit working. Janette said the Root Wedding Party with 300 guests went very well. She will check with Mike Yowell to see if he could donate coolers to replace those that have disappeared.

Pro Shop/Tournaments/Membership: Steve Johnson said the Member Guest Tournament was well attended with ten flights. The change to Friday and Saturday has not diminished the attendance. The women's flights need more participation. The upcoming Fike Memorial and Elk's Tournaments have a full field. Barbara asked if Couple's Play could be changed from Friday afternoon to Sunday morning. They will reserve only three to four tee times, so members' play will not be adversely affected. Bill Porter asked to switch cart locations in the barn. Mitch said the members can make those arrangements between themselves. Ryan will ask the Parkers to make a decision regarding their membership and cart space by August 1. Barbara said members would like the dress code enforced. Steve will remind members of the dress code in his next newsletter. The dress code pertains to members as well as guests on the golf course.

Greens/Water: Chris reported they have finished spraying for clover and dandelions, planting new trees on #6 and 7, and started mulching under trees where grass will not grow. They continue to seed dead Poa areas on fairways, level trenches, smooth the parking lot and cart paths, edge sprinkler heads and verti-cut and top dress greens on a weekly basis. Future plans are to seed areas on #11, 12, 13 and 14.
